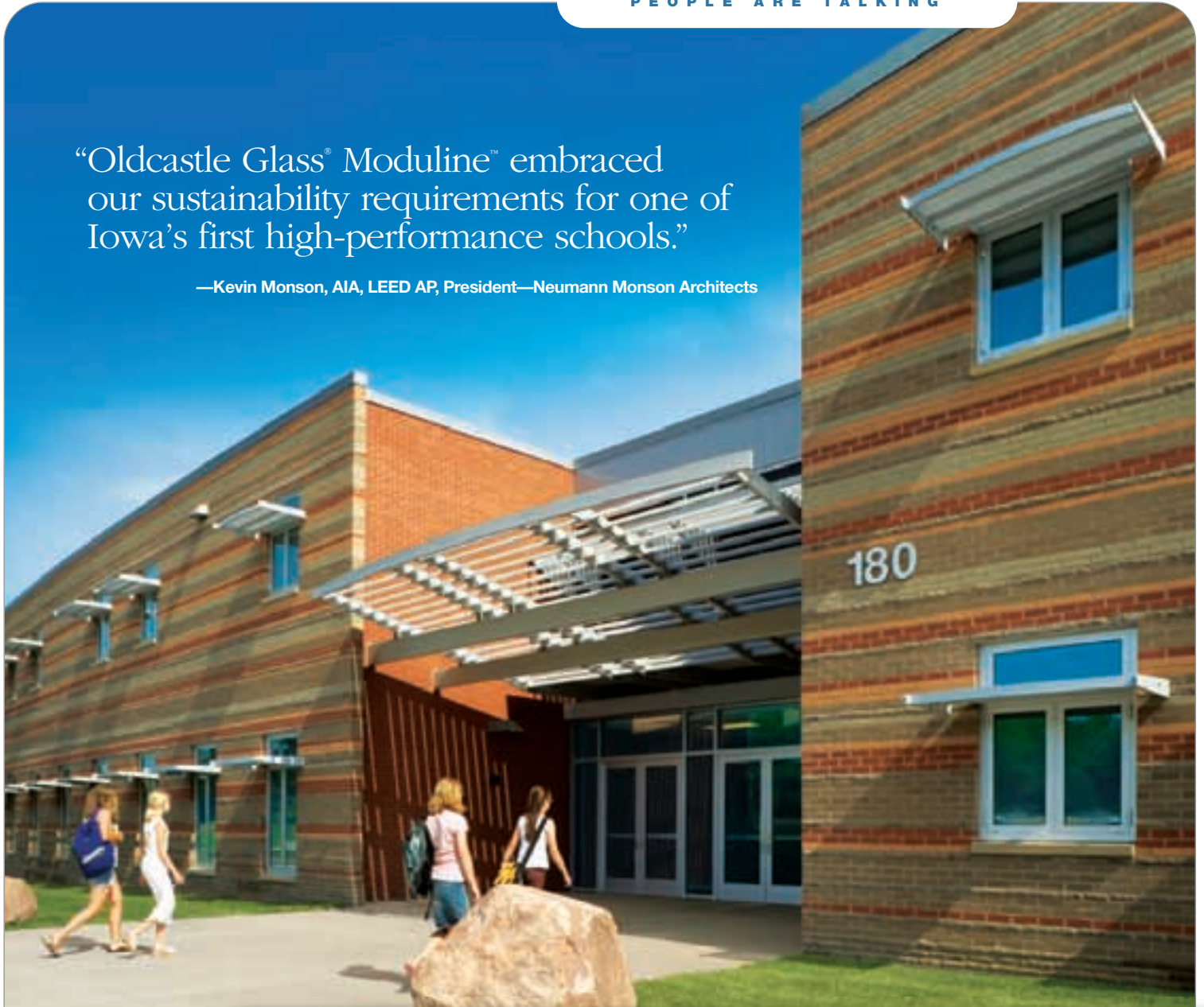

Along with its southern elevation, the building curves gently and allows southern perimeter windows to admit maximum daylight while exterior sunscreens eliminate glare. Shading devices and light shelves on the south-facing windows bounce daylight deep into the interior. As a result, natural light is optimized while maintenance and operating costs are reduced.
